1.2 Terms and Conditions

The following terms and conditions shall apply to all students when making payments;

- 1.2.1 All payments must be made through Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) and no cash payments are to be made at any campus or individuals. All Cash Deposits attracts 3% Cash Handling Fee which is deducted from the amount deposited. **PLEASE NOTE THAT IF YOU DEPOSIT CASH INTO OUR BANK ACCOUNT TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE 3% CASH HANDLING FEE THAT THE BANKS CHARGE.**

Students are advised to use EFT and the Point-of-Sale devices/Speed points located at all our campuses countrywide when making payments.

- 1.2.2 Students must present their student cards to avoid incorrect student numbers when presenting proof of payment at the Finance Office and Campus Administrators Office.

2. TUITION FEES

The following shall apply:

2.1 Each qualification is offered one module at a time within a period of four (4) weeks and fees are paid on a modular basis.

2.3 No transcripts/examination results shall be released to any student before clearing all outstanding fees.

3. BURSARY STUDENTS

3.2 Written proof/contract of bursaries/loan/grant awarded must be provided by sponsored students at registration.

3.3 NSFAP students to pay full registration fees and deposits upon registration and required to continue with payments until such a time the student receives a final award letter.

6. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 6.1 No cash payments should be made without obtaining an official receipt from Finance.

7. REFUND POLICY

- 7.1 The application fee is not refundable.
- 7.2 Cancellation of module within the first week after registration – 100% of tuition fees
- 7.3 Cancellation of module within the first two weeks after registration – 50% of tuition fees
- 7.4 Cancellation of course three weeks (or more) after registration – no refund
- 7.5 All refunds will attract a N\$300 Transaction and administration fee)**
- 7.6 Application for refund is done through the finance office and the date of the e-mail or stamped date on receipt by the Finance office will determine the effective date of cancellation.
- 7.7 No refunds of credit balances will be considered without written consent of the donor/sponsor/parent.
